IN RE: COURT OPERATIONS DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

On March 16, 2020, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern and Western

Districts of Arkansas suspended all IN COURT hearings until further notice in recognition of and

in deference to the possible pandemic ramifications of the COVID-19 virus. Since that time, the

Bankruptcy Clerk's offices in both Little Rock and Fayetteville, Arkansas, have remained open

and operational. Considering the severity of risk posed to the attorneys, litigants, and court staff,

this Order extends the moratorium on in court proceedings.

The court will not resume IN COURT hearings on July 1, 2020 and will continue

conducting hearings and trials both telephonically and by video conference at least through July

31, 2020.

Unless amended by this Order, all other provisions of the Administrative Order dated

March 16, 2020 remain in effect.
