General Order No. 43

On January 28, 2020, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern and Western Districts of Arkansas (the “Court”) entered General Order No. 40 (Adoption of Interim Bankruptcy Rules Implementing the Small Business Reorganization Act of 2019) adopting Interim Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure 1007, 1020, 2009, 2012, 2015, 3010, 3011, 3014, 3016, 3017.1, (new) 3017.2, 3018, and 3019.


On April 5, 2021, the Court entered Amended General Order No. 41 (Adoption of CARES Act Changes to Interim Rule 1020) adopting Interim Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 1020.

NOW, THEREFORE, the two General Orders are hereby revoked effective December 1, 2022, as the interim rules at issue relating to the Small Business Reorganization Act of 2019 and the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act of 2020 are part of the Bankruptcy Rules changes effective December 1, 2022.
