- Names of minor children to the initials;
- Dates of birth to the year.

In accordance with the *Judicial Conference Privacy Policy* cited above, please note the *Personal Data Identifier(s)* sought to be redacted from the transcript by page and line, as well as the manner in which the requested redaction(s) should occur. For example, a party seeking to redact the Social Security number 123-45-6789 appearing on page 12, line 9 of a transcript, would list:

Redact the Social Security number on page 12, line 9 to read xxx-xx-6789.
